TENNESSEN WARNING

I. PURPOSE

It is the policy of the Board of KIPP Minnesota that collection of personal or confidential data from employees or students be obtained in conformance with the requirements of the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

Any individual collecting private or confidential data on behalf of KIPP Minnesota will provide a Tennesen warning that complies with the sample warning to follow, unless applicable law provides an exception to the need to provide this warning.
